- 2. Candidates for membership are people who have experienced the revelation that they are not of the herd. In fact, they must think of themselves as unique and unquestionably elite: wolves rather than sheep. Members believe that worship is for the weak and contrition is for the terrorized.
- 3. Candidates for membership are those who are self confident; natural leaders. The Odin Brotherhood is an order of equals. There are no followers in the Brotherhood.
- 4. Candidates for membership are those who value strength and self reliance. The Odin Brotherhood has no place for the weak-spirited. Members would rather steal than accept charity.
- 5. Candidates for membership will be trustworthy and honorable. Their word must always be a sacred bond.
- 6. Candidates for membership are those who have come to the realization that fear profits a man nothing.
- 7. Candidates for membership are folk who renounce faith as a poison of the mind.
- 8. Candidates for membership are those who have received a sacred revelation, a calling of the Gods, often received in a potent dream or vision.
- 9. Candidates for membership are those who will, when properly prepared, venture to the wild where they will hallow, devote and sanctify their blood to the Gods-Who-Live.

The Odin Brotherhood represents an ancient way for those who walk the Warrior path of their ancestors. It is a creed of iron for those who understand the meaning of power, a guidepost for those who seek freedom and a sanctuary for those who value knowledge.
